1. DEAN PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION

To provide the children with a special memento of an 25th Anniversary wrist band and provide other commemorative items.

2. CURRIE DAY CENTRE - older person exercise classes

For monthly seated exercise classes by specialist instructor.

3. PENTLAND DUKE OF EDINBURGH, Balerno CHS, gold group

To assist 16 participants undertake a 4 day/3 overnight canoe adventure challenge along Great Glen.
